Our Resident Auditor Team takes the time to look into every detail of what happens behind the scenes at Westward.

Supported by the Resident Involvement staff, they produce comprehensive reports highlighting good practice and making recommendations for continuous improvement.

Resident Auditors have specialist training in all areas of skills needed for the role before they can begin as an Auditor and whilst they remain in the team. All team members are required to sign a confidentiality agreement.

Each inspection requires the Auditors to meet *a minimum* of once a month, although many inspections require more frequent meetings than this. Auditors are also expected to do some work between the meetings.

You will receive expenses to cover home broadband costs and an allowance to cover expenses for each day you work as an Auditor. In addition, all travel and reasonable care costs are reimbursed.

## ***Interested in joining the team?***

We believe it is essential that both the residents and landlord are part of the decision-making process as to whether the applicant is suited to the job and whether the job will suit them. A recruitment process enables applicants to have a 'taster' of the role and allows the Resident Auditor Team to assess people's interest and suitability, taking full account of the desire to provide equal and fair opportunities.
